David M. Helbraun is a principal of Helbraun Law Firm and a graduate of Yale University and of UC Law San Francisco (formerly Hastings). Mr. Helbraun primarily focuses on legal malpractice and civil rights matters, and has extensive practice in professional liability litigation involving lawyers, architects, real estate and insurance professionals, including trial and appellate work in those areas.

Mr. Helbraun has successfully litigated numerous police misconduct and related civil rights cases through trial and appeals in State and Federal courts. Mr. Helbraun served as a lecturer on legal ethics and avoiding legal malpractice, written articles on internet domain name infringement, and co-authored the Insurance Settlement Handbook. He served for several years on the California State Bar Committee on Professional Liability Insurance, overseeing the State Bar endorsed insurance program for California attorneys and was a founder of the Lavender Law Conference and the National LGBTQ+ Bar Association.
