Legal Professionals Incorporated (hereinafter “LPI”) offers scholarships to persons desiring a career in the legal field. A career in the “legal field” shall be interpreted and defined as follows: (i) legal secretary; (ii) legal assistant (including paralegal); (iii) court reporter; (iv) law office administrator; and (v) court clerks. Scholarships are not intended for students planning to enter law school.

**All applicants must be U.S. citizens and legal residents of the State of California, (ii) living in California during the scholarship year, (iii) attending a school in California, or in the alternative, an online ABA Accredited Program during the scholarship year (September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022), and (iv) enrolled in a program of no less than six months in duration. High school students who have not yet finalized their college plans acknowledge that the decision to attend school outside of the State of California, even if such decision is made after a scholarship has been awarded, will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship award.**

Members of LPI are not eligible for LPI scholarships. Relatives of LPI members are eligible as long as they meet the criteria as set forth in the Plan of Administration.

The application and accompanying documentation (see checklist) should be neatly handwritten and/or typewritten and on current forms. An original, signed application must be submitted. Applications via fax or email are not accepted.
